- OBJECTIVES:**
- Provide defense acquisition expertise for the Consolidated Afloat Network and Enterprise Services (CANES) program.
 - Provide program and acquisition management expertise in the sustainment of the Integrated Shipboard Network System (ISNS) Increment 1 program, CENTRIXS-M Program, and the Submarine Network (SUBLAN) program.
 - Management of schedules involving ship installations, systems engineering efforts, and document management.
 - Perform Pre-Acquisition activities including document development, Plan of Actions and Milestones (POA&M) and scheduling in preparation for Milestone decisions for the programs.
 - Ensure all statutory and regulatory requirements are met within acquisition documentation in order to achieve approval at major milestones.
 - Provide financial and budget management support in preparation and maintenance of Program Objective Memorandums (POM), Program Reviews (PR), budgets, and Spend Plans.
 - Provide acquisition documentation, briefing material, fielding plans, and budgetary reports in support of program requirements.
 - Perform risk management in order to identify program risks regarding cost, schedule and performance.
- RESULTS:** The project resulted in the following:
- Provided input resulting in successful milestone decisions of several Acquisition Decision Memorandums (ADMs).
 - Created briefings for the fleet and DoD leadership outlining the current status and future direction of the ISNS, CENTRIX-M and SUBLAN programs; briefs included PEO C4I Seminars, ACTs, Fleet Stakeholders brief, Fleet C4I Seminar, and JCIDS FCB brief for CPD approval.
 - Led CANES team through first successful Material Development Decision (MDD) in accordance with revised DoD 5000.01 instructions.
 - Led CANES acquisition support team, mentored key government personnel, and postured program for Milestone B approval.
 - Supported acquisition authority to procure and field End of Life (EOL) replacement for very old legacy software and hardware systems.

- Strategic input resulted in PEO C4I decision to procure and field the ISNS CCE system and pursue research and development efforts towards a Service Oriented Architecture (SOA) solution.
- Provided input resulting in the successful Acquisition Coordination Team (ACT) program milestone decision.
